Voluntary Water Restrictions

The voluntary water restrictions for the Dillon Valley District from May 1st to October 1st are:

- * Outside usage is not allowed on Mondays
- * The water days for properties whose street address ends in an **odd number** are Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday

* The water days for properties whose street address ends in an **even number** including 0, are Wednesday, Friday and Sunday

* Outside usage is not encouraged between the hours of 9am and 6pm

* Make sure your sprinkler is only watering your lawn. **DO NOT** water the gutter or road.

- * Never run an open hose, always us a nozzle with a shut off
- * Hand watering, using either a watering can or hose with a shut off nozzle is **ALLOWED** at any time with no restrictions

* Do not overwater your lawn. To test if your lawn is adequately watered step on your grass, if it springs back up when you move your foot, it does not need water.

2025 USER RATES. The 2025 user rates are in effect

as of January 1, 2025, and will be reflected in the 1st quarter 2025 billing statements. The rate increases for 2025 are required to cover increasing costs in operations and repairs, and to build reserve funds for water and sewer line improvements.

Sewer: \$164.78 per quarter per EQR

Water: \$127.68 per quarter per unit base rate plus usage Water Usage:

0 to 15,000 gallons	\$6.44 per 1,000 gallons
15,001 to 25,000 gallons	\$8.03 per 1,000 gallons
25,001 to 50,000 gallons	\$9.67 per 1,000 gallons
50,001 to 75,000 gallons	\$12.85 per 1,000 gallons
Over 75,000 gallons	\$16.10 per 1,000 gallons
A 5% late fee is applied quarterly to any balance not paid	
within 30 days of billing.	

OWNER RESPONSIBILITIES

All water meters are the property of the Owner. Owners are responsible for the maintenance of their water meter(s). The Owner shall provide the District access to the water meter if needed for the District to read and/or inspect the water meter. The Service Line, Curb Stop service box, marker post, shut off valve(s), and pressure reducing devices shall be owned and maintained by the Owner. All costs and expenses of the installation and construction of Service Lines shall be borne by the Owner. The Owner shall indemnify the District from any loss or damage that may directly or indirectly be occasioned by the installation of the Service Line(s) or connection to the system.

WATER/SEWER BILL PAYMENT OPTIONS

- A check made out to Dillon Valley Metro District and mailed to PO BOX 3428 Dillon, CO 80435
- Credit/Debit Card payments can be made through the State of Colorado payment system. Access the online payment system through dillonvalleymetro.com The State system has a nominal fee for credit card payments. The fee amount will be indicated to you as you are making the payment prior to the final payment authorization. You will need your Dillon Valley District account number, account name, property address and billing amount to process the credit card payment.
- Electronic Check payments can also be initiated through the State of Colorado payment system. Access the online payment system though dillonvalleymetro.com. If you chose the electronic check option under 'payment type option' on the Colorado portal, it will direct you to enter your account information. There is a flat rate processing fee of \$1.00 for all electronic check payments.
- Online Banking Bill pay can be initiated through your banking online system. You must verify that your checks are payable to the Dillon Valley District and include your account number.
